Graduate scholarship of \$500 to a student with excellent academic achievement and community service involvement. Selected by club committee from applications received from the school.

Life Skills graduate scholarship of \$500 to a student who has achieved despite hardship and who has a desire to further their education. This student is to be recommended by the school staff.

Key Leadership Camp - The 3 day program is held in September at Camp Wawbeek in Wisconsin Dells. We ask that interested students age 14-18 submit a written statement of their reasons and expectations for attendance. Kiwanis will select the best applicant(s) based on their request and school staff recommendations.

World Affairs Seminar – This multicultural learning experience for students age 16-18 (having completed sophomore thru senior year) is held in June at Carroll University, Waukesha, WI. Our sponsorship is possible due to a special fund established in memory of Bob Belle. Interested area students complete an application form and Kiwanis will make selections.

Middle School Achievement Banquet -Kiwanis recognizes outstanding middle school students in five study areas (mathematics, science, language arts, social studies, fine arts). Students are nominated by school staff. The students will be honored and receive certificates at an event in April. Students and their parents are our guests and enjoy dinner and the short program which encourages them to consider continued learning and service to others in their future.

For young children - Kiwanis and Belleville Econo-misers volunteer readers conduct monthly reading sessions with K4 children. With community business support we purchase 7 books which are read in class and then given to each student to take home for family read-together enjoyment.

Autism iPads – Kiwanis provides ipads and needed learning apps for students with Autism spectrum disorder who might benefit from this learning tool.
